



## **How to make a Pencil Sketch Tutorial by Ann**

**I learned to do this in a Paintshop Pro class on the Internet. Scott Munroe developed the technique for that program and I adapted it to Photoshop for this tutorial. I like to use it for landscapes.**

- 1. Open a photo of your choice**
- 2. Duplicate layer (Layers/duplicate) Keep second layer active**
- 3. Convert to grayscale (Image/Mode/Grayscale)**
- 4. Invert (Image/Adjust/Invert Do not flatten image)**
- 5. On layers menu scroll to color dodge instead of normal**
- 6. This will turn your image white. Use the slider to adjust your opacity. I usually use about 80%**
- 7. Go to Filter/Blur/Gaussian either 2 or 3 whichever you prefer.**
- 8. Go to layers/flatten and save as a jpg.**
